COVID-19 CHRISTMAS

This will be a very different kind of Christmas Season, a COVID-19 Christmas, if you will. It is no secret that COVID-19 is causing all sorts of interruptions to our normal Christmas plans, however that should not distract us from the real meaning of Christmas; it should propel us toward it.

Plans will be disrupted in our community, our church, and our family. Those traditions will have to wait a year. Let us not pretend that does not make us a bit sad, and maybe even angry, that we cannot go about Christmas as we always have, making those great memories with family and friends.

However, this interruption by a virus should get our attention. Maybe we have slipped into comfortable routines for Christmas. Traditions are good, do not get me wrong, but maybe because some of the clutter of traditions are cut away this year, we can again re-focus on the true meaning of Christmas.

November 29 begins the Advent Season in the church calendar. Advent is a season of expectant waiting and preparation for the celebration of the birth of Christ at Christmas. On each of the four Sundays leading up to Christmas, the church focuses on some aspect of the Christmas story - usually through the sermon, music, and the Advent Wreath.

Each candle of the wreath represents a part of the Christmas story - hope (Prophet's Message), faith (Bethlehem), joy (Mary/ Shepherds), peace (Angels), and the fifth candle is the Christ Candle lit on Christmas Eve.

Amidst the interruptions this year, let us use the Advent Season as real preparation to celebrate the birth of our Lord and Savior - the Kings of Kings, and Lord of Lords. As part of the preparation, I offer you the Luke Challenge. The Gospel of Luke has twenty-four chapters, if you begin on December 1 reading a chapter a day, you will cover the life of Christ by Christmas Day. You can of course use your own Bible, or we have the Gospel of Luke booklets available at the church to use if you want to make notes or underline certain passages.

So, please join us Sundays at 10:30 AM, in person or online, during the Advent season as we look at the Christmas story, and all the interruptions it caused. Yet despite the interruptions, it was for our good and His glory.



IT SHOWS THE SPOT WHERE JESUS LAY A BABE SO SMALL TO SHOW THE WAY.


NOW WE DO KNOW THE ONE IS HERE THAT IS SENT FROM GOD AND OH SO DEAR.
