This month we are focusing on our Mission Ministry Team at FPC. Our Mission Team has the privilege to reach out in Jesus' name and help people within and outside our church in practical ways. They support both international and local missions through our financial giving and donations of time and resources. Internationally we support three missionary families located in Peru, Guatemala, and Nicaragua. Locally we support four mission organizations: Jesus Loves You Ministry, Crossroads Hope Academy, Misión Peniel, and St. Vincent de Paul. The following are updates from our supported missions. Our mission as a family is to connect people with disabilities to Jesus through the vibrant local church and help people to receive the gift of mobility through a wheelchair.

Our goals for this year 2021 will be to fully train and support all ministries, pastors, and volunteers within the church in order to be a more inclusive church in all areas of the church, to help them receive and support families with family members with a disability in all areas of the church. We pray that this will be both online as it is now, but also in person when the church reopens to in-person services in the future.

Personal Life and Prayer Requests

- 1. We have moved forward in the now 3 year adoption process. Praise God. Kaleb's case is FINALLY in the office of adoptions! Our process is NEW to their normal way of doing things so we are praying for favor and speed in getting this all done. We pray that our lawyer who has been with us through all of this will be able to navigate this process well and help move it forward.
- 2. On July 28th Peru's new president will take office. He is a known extreme leftist with communistic viewpoint. Please pray for the direction, safety, and provision for Peru.
- 3. Vaccinations have been much slower here in Peru. But they are slowly rolling out the vaccines and are slowly decreasing precautions that were once so strict. We do still have to wear double masks out in public.
- 4. We continue to balance a full case load of work with virtual learning school 5 days a week for Kaleb. He is halfway through 4-yr old preschool and really would love to end the 2nd half in person learning. We are praying for this to be a possibility with the vaccine roll out.
- 5. Our landlord is planning to sell our current apartment that we LOVE and have lived in the past 3 years. Please pray that if it sells, that we have a better living option presented to us at just the right time in the perfect location that fits our needs.

Our mission is to use the sport of Ultimate as a tool to promote strong Biblical character development in youth and young adults.

One way to enter a community or local school with the Gospel is to first introduce them to a sport. As teams are formed, then leagues and finally large-scale tournaments, we have the opportunity to make a greater impact on the youth. As each team gathers for practice, part of the time is spent going through our Bible-based curriculum. Our ministry is based in Zacapa, a hot, arid, desert-like region in the northeast. Zacapa also exemplifies the mission paradox of Guatemala in that while being one of the most evangelized countries in the world according to Joshua Project data, it is continually ranked as one of the most violent countries in the world, especially against women. The Stone's ministries are designed to promote a Christian culture via education and practical training that help folks make decisions that facilitate an orderly, God ordained existence in the face of growing social chaos.

Jesus Loves You Ministry is a mobile outreach program of the homeless in southwest Florida. We provide the following services: Transportation to and from appointments; mobile lunch program; portable shower truck; case management; benefit application assistance; facilitate medical and mental health treatment; resource referrals; weekly men's, women's and Jesuslovesyouministryinc.com co-ed Bible studies; food pantry and hygiene closet; mobile lunch truck; and much more.

Crossroads Hope Academy is a home and school for foster boys who have had multiple failed placements in the Florida foster care system. Making the transition from family life – even dysfunctional family life - to foster child is an unimaginably difficult proposition. Some kids have substantial complications for which the current foster care system is not well equipped to handle. These kids get moved from failed placement to failed placement. Their esteem suffers; they fall behind in school or drop out; many end up homeless. Crossroads specializes in these cases.

At Crossroads we take in these boys, between 12 and 18 years of age, and offer them a stable home - for most it is the first stable home they have ever known. Crossroads has specially trained staff, counselors, and teachers who work to retrieve these kids from despair and help them grow and transition into well-adjusted and self-sufficient adults. Crossroads would not be successful without the financial and volunteer support of our community. Providing the level of interaction, intercession, and care these boys need is much more costly than it is to meet the needs of kids who have not gone through their trauma. These costs are recouped by society ten-fold in the future as we break the cycle of government dependence, crime and irresponsible behavior which so often befalls kids who are otherwise abandoned.

Misión Peniel began as a pastoral ministry of charity and service, providing food, clothing, fellowship and emergency support to farmworkers in Immokalee in September of 2006. Beginning in 2013, Misión Peniel became a ministry of Peace River Presbytery while continuing to be a vehicle for people of faith to respond to a call for compassionate service to complement the focus on social justice provided so aptly through the Coalition of Immokalee Workers. Under the leadership of Pastor Miguel Estrada, they address the isolation and injustice among migrant workers in Immokalee and provide support through spiritual and material care. They bring together people of faith and compassion to act with farm workers to achieve fundamental change in their living and working conditions.
